

Students 6 Months to 5 Years:

Parent/Child Level 1: 6 months to 2 years of age, Parental assist in the water. Introduces basic skills to parents and children.

Parent/Child Level 2: 2 to 4 years of age, Parental assist in the water. Builds on skills introduced in Parent/Child Level 1.

Preschool Aquatics Level 1: Ages 3, 4, 5. Elementary aquatic skills and safety practices

Preschool Aquatics Level 2: Ages 3, 4 and 5. Beginning independent aquatic locomotion skills.

Preschool Aquatics Level 3: Ages 3, 4 and 5. Swimming skills are now performed independently.

Students Ages 6 and Above:

- Level 1: Elementary aquatic skills and safety practices
- Level 2: Beginning of independent aquatic locomotion skills.
- Level 3: Beginning of stroke development (front crawl, elementary backstroke and sidestroke).
- Level 4: Refining Front crawl, elementary backstroke, side stroke. Learn breaststroke, butterfly, and back crawl.
- Level 5/6: Working towards stroke perfection with advanced water safety and survival skills.
- Adult 1: Beginner level, shallow water swimming.
- Adult 2: Advanced level, shallow and deep water swimming.
