- -The Elizabeth Lee Black School, an approved private school for students ages 3 through 21 with autism, intellectual disabilities and multiple challenges.
- Bright Beginning early intervention therapies for infants and toddlers
- Happy Hearts Preschool, featuring "inclusive" classrooms for typically-developing children and students with disabilities
- The region's only preschool program for children who are deaf and hard of hearing
- -Pre-K Counts classes with full-day preschool for "at-risk" children

Barber Behavioral Health Institute

A wide range of therapies, psychological and behavioral services, and supports for any child or adolescent with mental health challenges:

- -Barber Behavioral Health Institute Outpatient Clinic offering counseling and medication management for children, adults, couples and families
- -Behavioral Health Rehabilitation Services (BHRS) and mobile therapy in the home and in school
- -Family counseling, grief and trauma therapy for children, and social skills development
- -Partial hospitalization programs for children to meet acute needs and prevent out-of-home placement
- -Psychiatric service for adults with autism or intellectual disabilities





Employment & Vocational Services

Opportunities for adults to develop skills needed to live as independently as possible:

- -Day Supports Programs with activities that promote recreational and daily living skills
- -Supported Employment Program with placement in jobs in the community
- -Transitional Work Service to build skills for employment
- -Retirement Center with recreational and therapeutic activities for an aging population

Living in the Community

- -Residential homes in neighborhood settings
- -Supported Living, enabling individuals to reside in their own apartments or homes with staff support
- -Lifesharing, linking families to share their homes with an individual for a long-term relationship
- -Expanding Socialization Opportunities (ESO) dances for young adults in collaboration with area colleges
