The puppets have been used in classrooms all over the country. Our group of puppets include individuals who have Down Syndrome, Hearing and Visual Deficits, Cerebral Palsy, Autism, ADHD, Epilepsy, and Learning Disabilities. In addition, we have puppets that are siblings of those with different abilities as well as other puppets that are a part of our troupe.

The best part of the performance is that people, both children and adults, can learn from each of the KIDS ON THE BLOCK. They can learn an attitude of understanding, warmth, and sensitivity that will serve them well for the rest of their lives.
