## What is TIME FOR ME?

**Time for Me** is a program designed for children with an intellectual disability, ages 4 through 15 years (their 16th birthday is the cutoff date.)

Attendees enjoy structured activities including swimming, crafts and gym at the Barber National Institute. Snacks are also served.

Parents have their own "Time for Me" knowing that their children are in a safe environment, having fun and are well supervised by trained staff. T.S.S. are welcomed to attend.

Sessions are fee-based and limited to 12 children per session. Fee is \$15/first child and \$10/ each additional child. FSS funds may be utilized as payment.

Sessions are held on the second Saturday of the month from 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM.
