## What is TFM?

Time for Me is a program designed for children with an intellectual disability, ages 4-15 (their 16th birthday is the cutoff date).

Attendees enjoy structured activities including swimming, crafts and gym at the Barber National Institute. Snacks are also served.

Parents have their own "Time for me" knowing their children are in a safe environment, having fun and are well supervised by trained staff. T.S.S are welcome to attend.

Sessions are fee based and limited to 5 children per session. Fee is \$15/first child and \$10/each additional child. FSS funds may be utilized as payment.
