A Note from ESO

Welcome to a new year of ESO! We are beginning our 18th year of ESO and we could not be more excited.

The support from our dancers and families, as well as the local universities is what keeps us going each year. We have a lot of fun dances planned this year and we wanted to inform you of an important change.

As many of you have seen, we have made quite a few improvements to the dances over the last 4 years. With increasing costs and in order to maintain the current dances with the DJ, snacks, decorations, games, etc., we have felt it was necessary to increase the cost of the dances to \$5, which is the first increase since the dances started. This will take effect at our first dance of the season, which will be the carnival.

With this being a new year, we have a few reminders for you:

- Safety is our main priority at the dances. Volunteers are onsite to dance with everyone and be a buddy. If your dancer requires one on one assistance due to medical or behavioral needs, please have a staff or family member attend the dance with them.
- It is important to make sure you are filling out your dancers permission slip with the correct information. The permission slip has important information on it that helps us keep your dancer safe. One of the most important lines to fill out correctly is how the dancer is getting picked up. We go by what the permission slip says. For example, if the slip is marked that they are walking home, we are unable to stop them as it is considered a rights violation.
- We ask that when picking up your dancer, please come into the building to pick them up. Our volunteers don't always know all the dancers and it can take longer for them to find your dancer and cause traffic to back up.

We greatly appreciate your understanding and dedication to ESO. We are looking forward to another wonderful year!
