How can Blended Case Management help?

Who can collaborate with Blended Case Management?

- Residential/Supported Living Staff
- Vocational Services
- Doctors (PCPs & Specialists)
- Behavioral Health Services
- Supports Coordination
- Career Exploration
- Psychiatrists
- Therapists

Who is eligible?

Any adult over age 18 diagnosed with a qualifying mental health diagnosis may be eligible for the program. Such mental health diagnoses may include:

- Anxiety Disorder
- Autism Spectrum Disorder
- Depression
- PTSD
- Schizophrenia



How can I access Blended Case Management Services?
